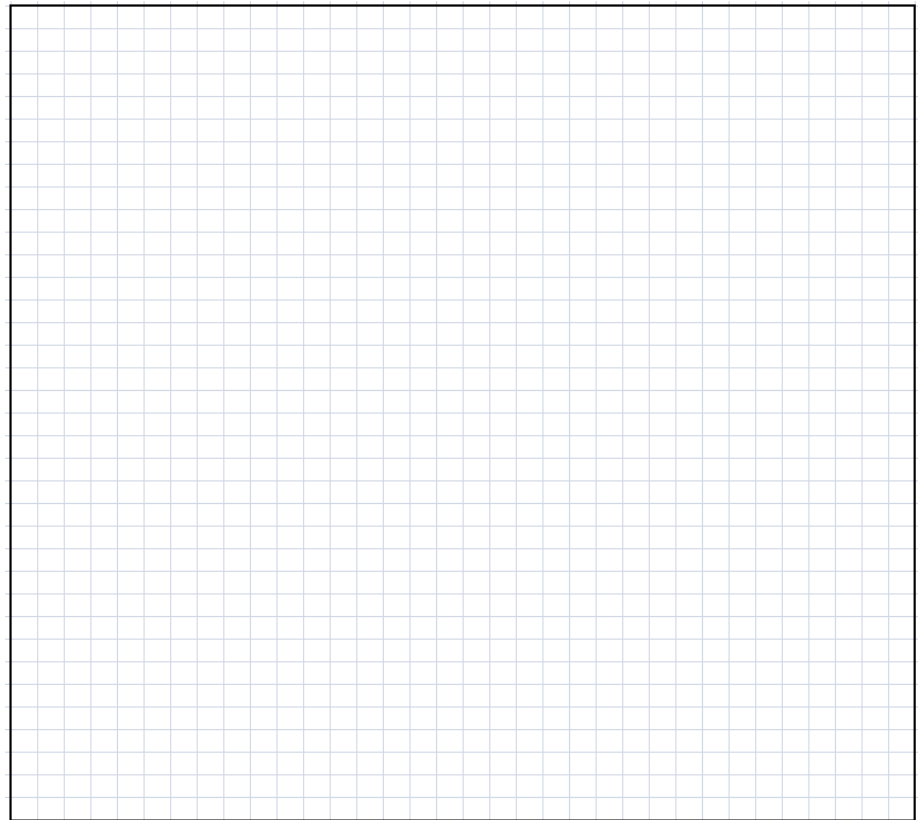


How to measure your space:

1. Draw a basic sketch of the birdseye view of the room.
2. Dimension the lengths of each wall on which cabinetry will sit
3. Identify window and door locations as dimensioned from the nearest wall, the width of the window or door will be from the outside of trim/casing to the outside of trim/casing
4. Note the height of windows from finished floor and also the full height of the opening (including trim)
5. Note the height of doors to top of casing
6. Please record the ceiling height in the space and the location and height of any bulkheads
7. List appliances on a separate page with measurements of each item
8. Indicate the locations of outlets/switches on the walls and the location of plumbing or gas lines as necessary
